Policy Statement

"The Chamber shall review and take a position on legislative issues which have significant fiscal impact on a material number of its membership. The Chamber shall not review and take a position on legislative issues which are primarily or solely of a social or non-fiscal nature". (Adopted - July, 1998)

Position Statements

Education

- Support legislation that provides for adequate school facilities to improve the educational environment.
- Oppose any legislation (state or federal) which imposes a mandate but provides inadequate financial support to carry out that mandate.

Economic Enhancement

- Supports city, county or state programs which provide assistance with business retention, expansion and/or attraction, and job creation.
- Supports legislation that provides incentive and tax returns to local communities.
- Opposes excessive environmental regulations and/or legislation.

Water

- Support water policies that ensure reliable sustainable water supplies to the Victor Valley to support long-term growth.
- Support and encourage the development of new water resources such as imported water, water conservation and recycled water.

Taxes

- Supports legislation that provides tax credits to businesses for things such as job creation, energy reduction and creation, recycling or air quality improvement.
- Opposes taxes that unreasonably targets the business community.
- Opposes legislation that increases worker's compensation and unemployment insurance to business owners.
- Supports legislation that ensures the return of local sales tax dollars to the point of origin (areas).
- Opposes tax increases which have not been approved by voters of the city, county or state in which any increases are proposed.
